

PAPER BAG SQUIRREL CRAFT

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MATERIALS LIST

- Paper lunch bag
- Scissors
- Newspaper
- Brown construction paper
- Scotch tape
- Markers
- Glue stick
- Squirrel craft template



Step 1

- Print out the squirrel craft templates. You can just print onto regular paper and use them as a template or print directly onto the brown construction paper. If you print straight onto the construction paper, just cut it down to the 8 1/2 x 11 inch size to fit properly.
- Cut out all of the pieces.



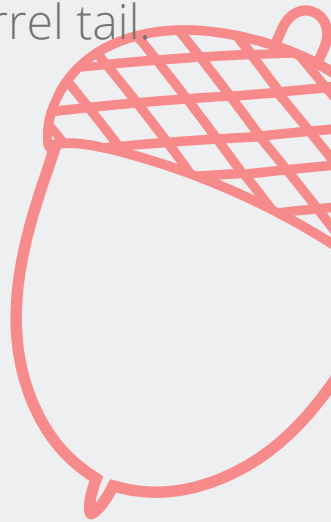
Step 2

- Use the glue stick to attach the squirrel arms to the paper bag.
- Then attach the squirrel tail.



Step 3

- Crumple up some strips of newspaper.
- Fill the paper lunch bag with the crumpled up newspaper. Just don't over-stuff it.



Step 4

- Pinch the top of the paper bag closed and secure it with scotch tape.



Step 5

- Attach the front of the squirrel's head using tape.
- Then glue the back of the head in place, sandwiching the closed top of the paper bag. (This step is optional)
- Add details to the squirrel's body using your markers.

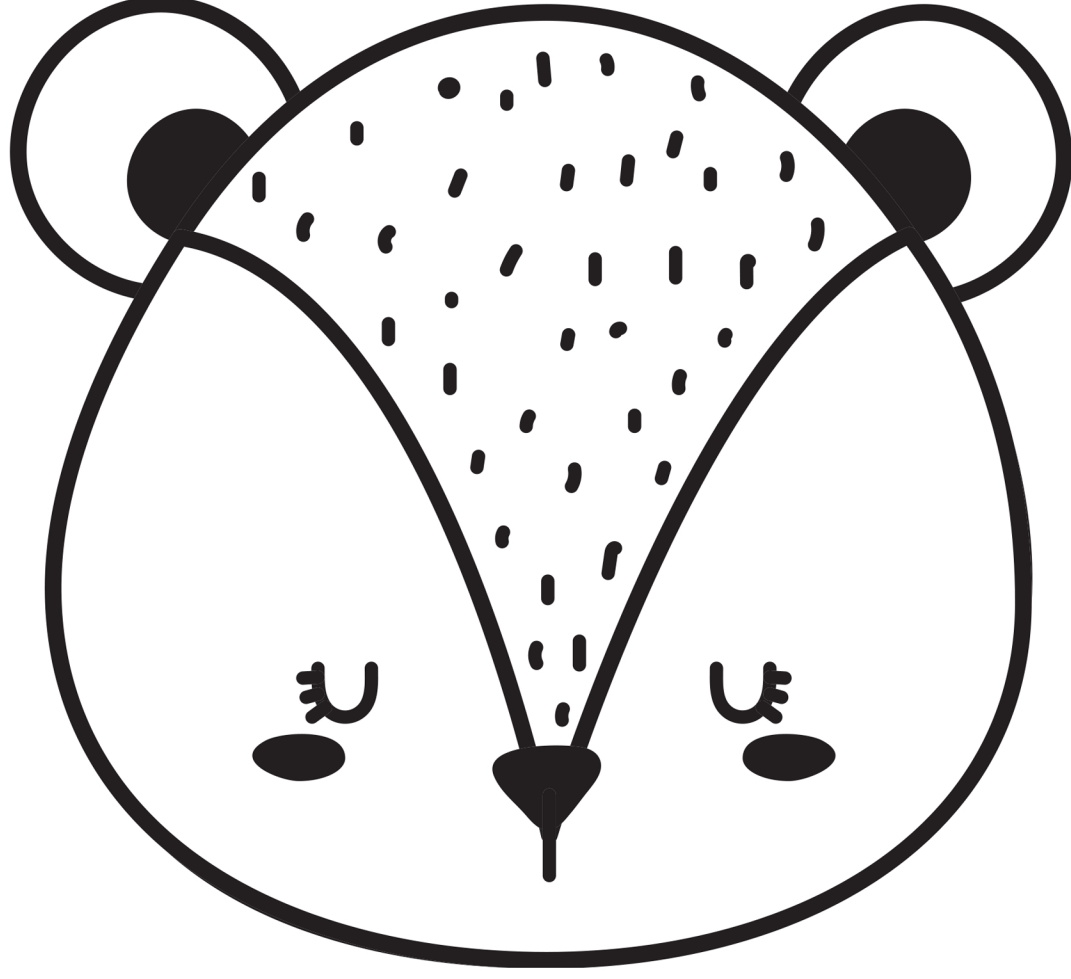
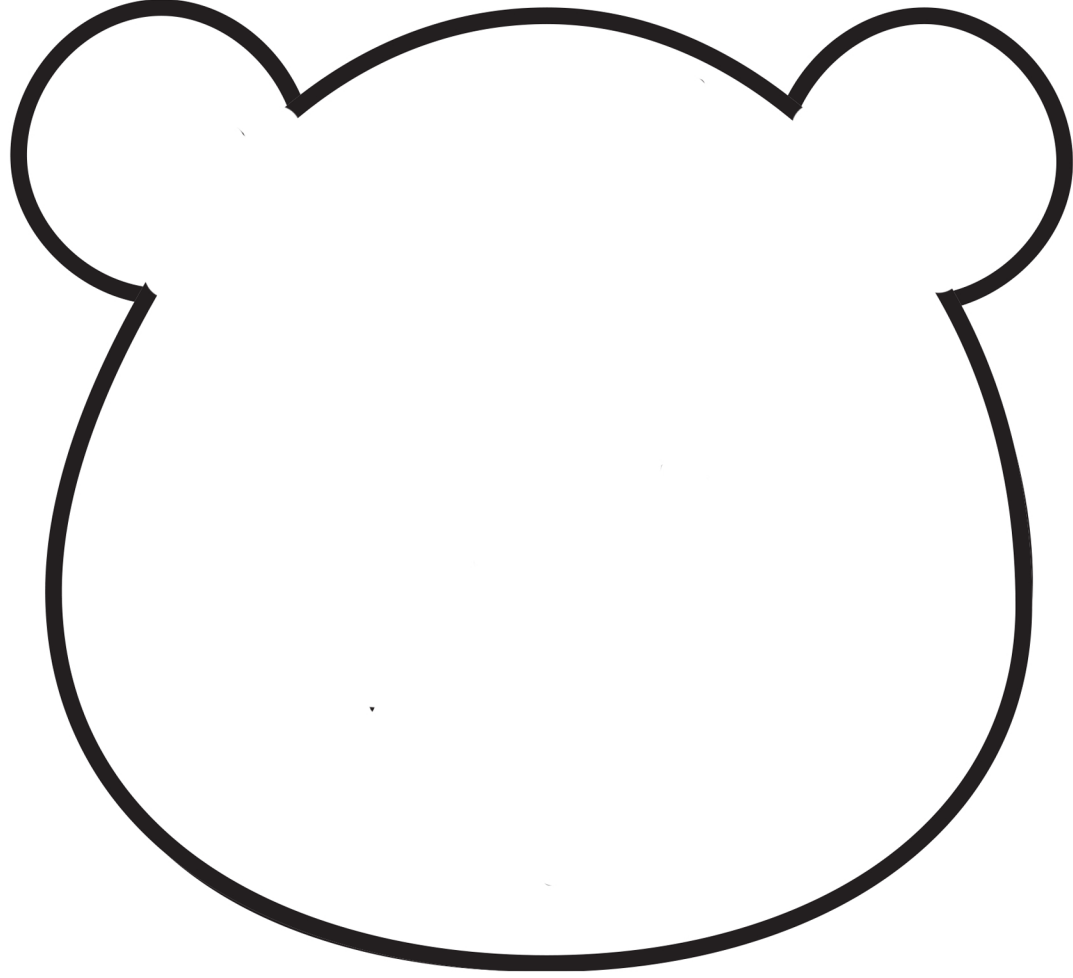


Step 6

- Glue the squirrel's feet in place.
- Next, glue the acorn so that it is being held by his hands.
- Use the markers to add any other details you like to finish off your paper squirrel craft.

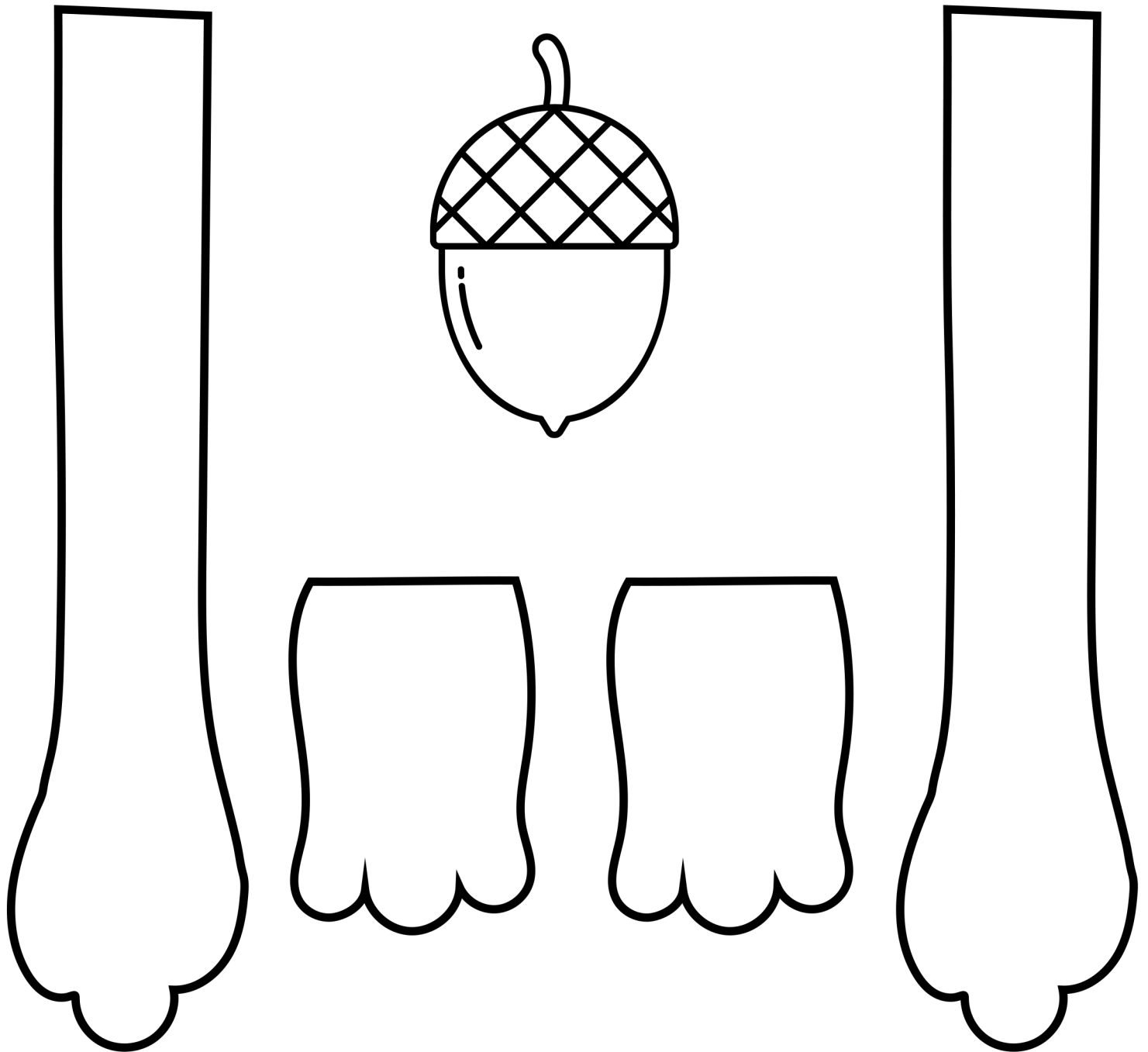


SQUIRREL CRAFT [PG. 1]



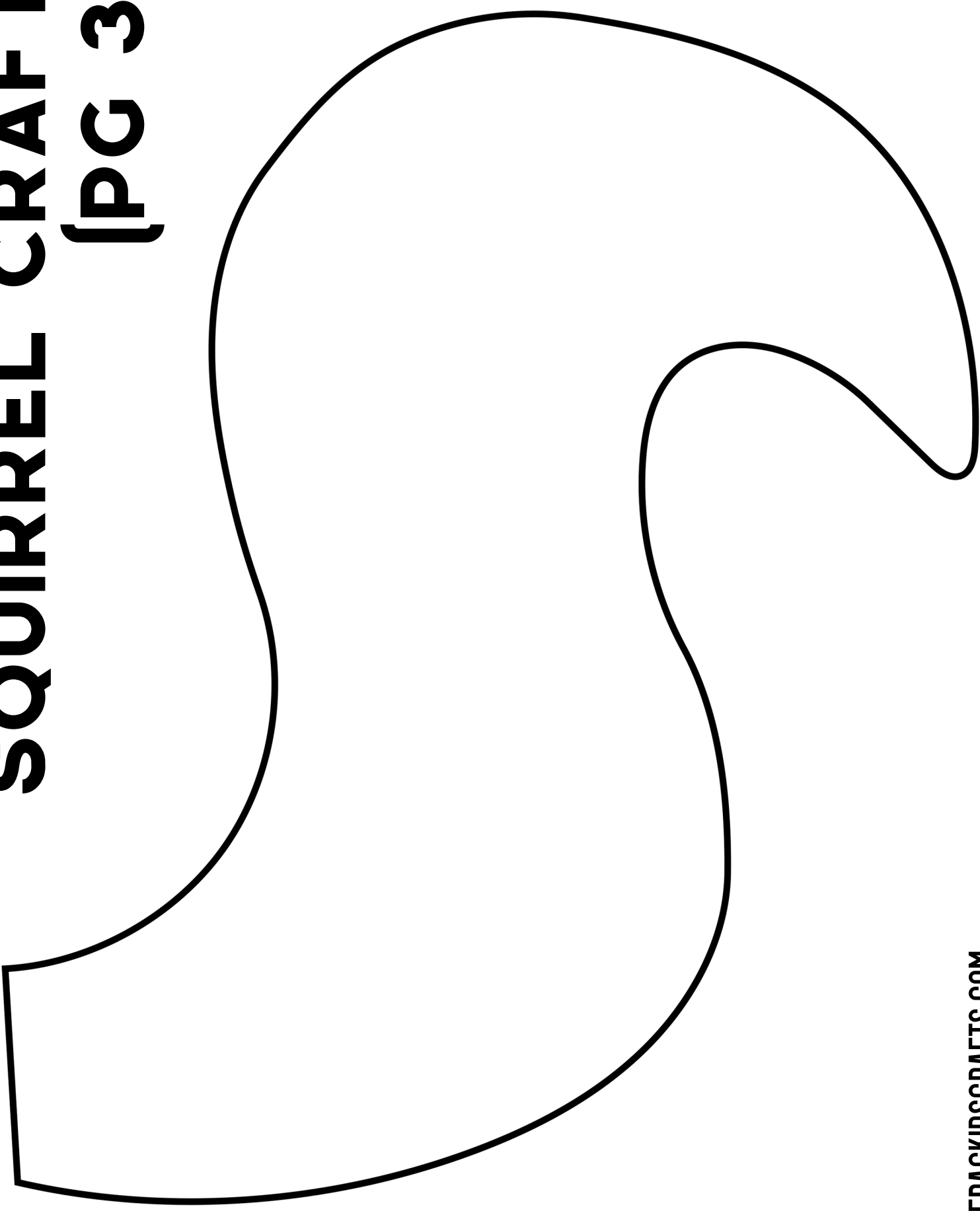
SQUIRREL CRAFT
