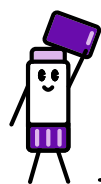

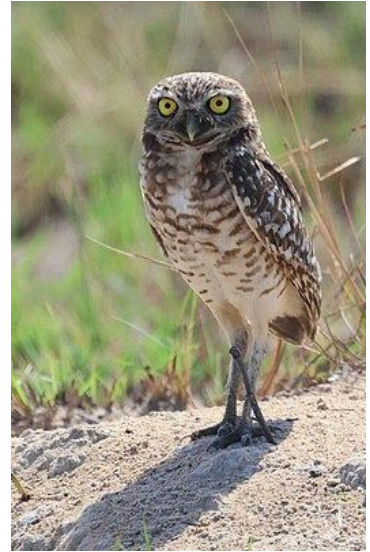
Barn Owl (*Tyto alba*)

Burrowing Owl (*Athene cunicularia*)

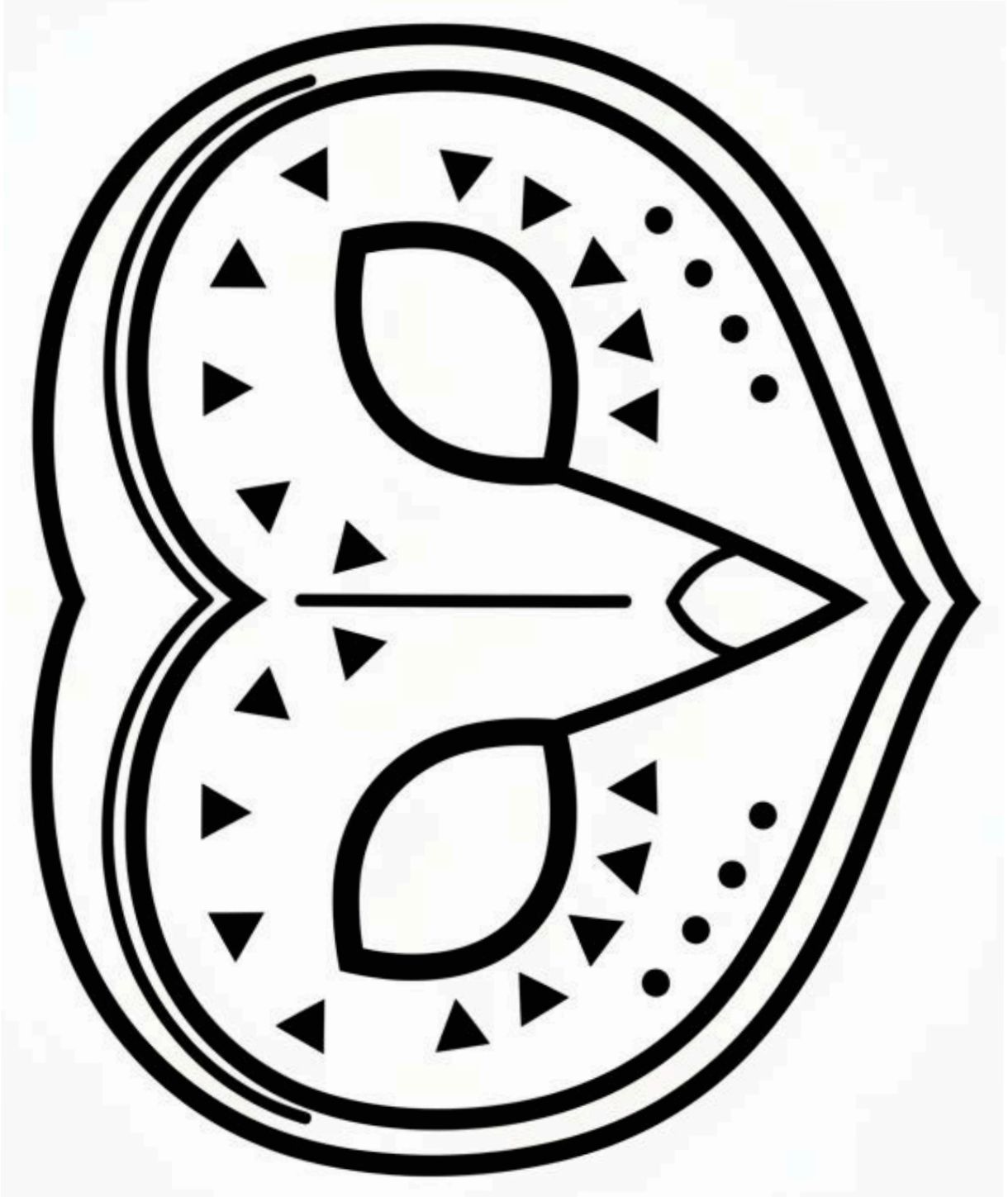

Owls are amazing creatures! Did you know there are about 250 different species of owls and that they're found on every continent except Antarctica? Owls have amazing adaptations that help them survive in the forest, the prairies and deserts, and even on farms or close to people! In this project, you'll be able to cut and color masks that make you look like three of the most recognizable owls in North America: Barn owls, great horned owls, and burrowing owls.

Project Steps

1. Print out the owl(s) you want to design
2. Think about the owl you've chosen. What specific adaptations make it perfect for its habitat? Think about the owl's size, color, ears, eyes, legs, and other characteristics.
3. Cut and color your owl.
4. Reinforce the hole area with scotch tape, then use a hole punch to make one hole on either side
5. Tie a stretchy string through both holes so it will stay on your face!
